DOLL UP A DULL FILING CABINET AND MAKE IT A PIECE YOU'LL BE PROUD TO DISPLAY. SIMPLY HEAD INTO YOUR LOCAL HARDWARE STORE TO GET YOUR MAKEOVER STARTED

Metal filing cabinets are certainly practical, but nobody really wants them on display. We've taken this humble cabinet and, with the help of Selley's No More Gaps Ezi Press, some MDF and timber moulding, turned it into a piece worthy of display.

STEPS

GATHER YOUR SUPPLIES

Metal filing cabinet; MDF Board; MDF moulding; handles; Selley's No More Gaps Ezi Press; Selley's Liquid Nails Ezi Press; Dulux Duramax Undercoat; Dulux Duramax Chalky Finish; Dulux Duramax Metal Primer Spray; power saw; mitre box; sander; drop sheet; dust mask.

HERE'S HOW

STEP 1 Cut 3mm MDF to size of drawer allowing a 3mm border all around. Measure size of square for moulding to make the frame and cut to size with mitre corners. Stick the moulding onto the MDF with Selley's Liquid Nails Ezi Press.

STEP 2 Fill all gaps around frame and moulding using Selley's No More Gaps Ezi Press.

STEP 3 Paint over the new frame sections with primer to seal.

STEP 4 Top coat with grey.

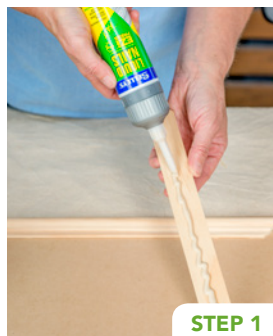
STEP 5 Remove old hardware from cabinet and give a light sand.

STEP 6 Prep with metal primer.

STEP 7 Top coat with grey.

STEP 8 Stick backing with the frame onto the cabinet again using Selley's Liquid Nails Ezi Press.

STEP 9 Add new handles.

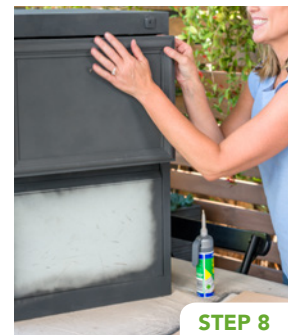
