

# WORK FROM HOME

SET UP A STYLISH HOME OFFICE BY UPCYCLING AN OLD DRESSER. SIMPLY TAKE THIS SHEET TO YOUR LOCAL HARDWARE STORE TO GET YOUR NEW DESK UNDERWAY

When your home work zone sits in an open area of your living space, the standard office-style desk might not do your interior style justice. We took an op-shop dressing table and removed the top drawers and mirror. After some light sanding and a bit of TLC, this lovely desk is ready for business!



## GATHER YOUR SUPPLIES

Op-shop dresser/desk and drawer handles. Dulux PRECISION High Opacity Stain Blocker; Dulux Duramax Chalky Finish; sander; drop sheet; dust mask.

## HERE'S HOW

**STEP 1** Remove the screws holding the top in place and dismantle.

**STEP 2** Sand the desk lightly to remove any ridges left on the surface. Remove the drawer handles and give the drawer fronts a light sanding.

**STEP 3** Spray entire desk with stain blocker, which prevents stains from migrating through the topcoat and hides dark stains and colours.

**STEP 4** Lightly sand again and spray with two coats of paint.
