

CHALK IT UP

YOU'LL NEVER MISS A MEMO AGAIN WITH THIS UPCYCLED PICTURE-TURNED-BLACKBOARD. SIMPLY PRINT THIS PROJECT SHEET AND DROP BY THE HARDWARE STORE TO GET STARTED

Blackboards are a terrific addition to a busy workspace, as they're perfect for to-do lists and reminders. We've repurposed an old frame to make this stylish version to hang above your office desk, so you'll never forget a thing.

GATHER YOUR SUPPLIES

Old frame; 6mm MDF board; Selley's No More Gaps Ezi Press; Selley's Liquid Nails Ezi Press; Dulux Design Chalkboard; Dulux 1 Step Acrylic Primer, Sealer & Undercoat; power saw; drop sheet; paint brush and roller; soft cloth.

HERE'S HOW TO

STEP 1 Carefully remove glass and artwork from the frame and clean up the edges.

STEP 2 Measure the dimensions inside the frame and have the 6mm MDF cut to size.

STEP 3 Lightly sand the old frame.

STEP 4 Use Selley's Liquid Nails Ezi Press to attach the frame to the backing board.

STEP 5 Use Selley's No More Gaps Ezi Press to fill the space between the frame and backing board.

STEP 6 Undercoat the frame with primer (tinted grey).

STEP 7 Paint the interior backing board with chalkboard paint.

STEP 8 Top coat the frame with a charcoal colour.

STEP 9 While still wet, wipe back using a soft cloth to reveal a little of the gold showing through.
