1 FIRST, DISTINGUISH WHAT'S A WEED
Before you get cracking, it's a good idea to check that you're getting rid of actual weeds, not natives or plants you want to keep. The Australian Government website has a nifty weed identification tool that will help you to be sure.

2 SPRAY WITH ORGANIC WEED KILLER
Choose a good-quality organic weed killer for a quick, effective result. 3 REMOVE DEAD WEEDS
Once the weeds are dead, pull them out and be sure to remove their roots. Remove any flowers or seeds they dropped before you spray to ensure they don't reinfest the area.

4 REPLANT YOUR GARDEN
Once you've removed the dead weeds, you can replant your garden. 5 MULCH WELL
Mulching is an important step in the process, as it smothers any opportunistic new weed shoots, locks in soil moisture and supports the growth of the plants you do want to grow. Always allow at least 2cm thickness for sufficient coverage.
